



Mr. Dobrosław Dowiāt-Urbański was appointed to the position of the Head of Civil Service by the Prime Minister in March 2016.

Mr. Dobrosław Dowiāt-Urbański studied law and German philology at universities in Lublin (UMCS), Freiburg and Cologne. He also graduated from the National School of Public Administration (KSAP) and the legislative application. He is a nominated civil servant. Since the completion of his education in KSAP in 1999, he has been employed in government administration, with one-year break, when as a scholar of the Robert Bosch Foundation, he held professional internships in the German federal ministries (mainly the Ministry of Foreign Affairs).

He started his professional career in the Office of Housing and Urban Development (afterwards transformed into the Ministry of Infrastructure), where he occupied positions at different levels, starting from chief specialist, through counsellor to the minister, the head of unit – up to the deputy director of the department.

Since 2008 Mr. Dobrosław Dowiāt-Urbański was employed on the position of the Deputy Director of the Legal Department at the Chancellery of the Prime Minister, where his main duties included legal support to the Head of Civil Service. He also participated as an expert in EU projects supporting the development of civil service and public administration in Albania, Serbia and Ukraine.
